1. MY MAKUENI COUNTY APP LAUNCH


The ICT Directorate launched my County App, a platform that will enable the county to digitize all services in a single integrated channel.

a) Introduction of Multi-Channels for Electronic/Cashless Collections which are USSD Payment via pabill numbers, STK push and self service portal:







Impact of Revenue Enhancement through Integration of Electronic Cashless Self Service Platforms Which include Hada za soko, Land /business permits and sema na governor.

- ➤ These has led to increase of own-source revenue by 140,749,882 million from a previous 749,406,507 to 890,156,389.
- ➤ Enhanced accountability and prudence in handling revenue collections.
- ➤ The multichannel payment gateways ensure uptime of 99.99% when one channel is experiencing downtimes.



Through this program 2125 ECDE care givers were trained and 2199 devices issued to ECDE Centers across the county. the program aims at:



3. CTTI Governance

The department, in an effort to promote sound governance systems, has developed County Technical Training Institute Board of Governors Guidelines, 2023

The Guidelines aim to foster skills training as espoused in the County Government Act, 2012 as follows;

- Delegation of authority to Boards of Governors in implementation of national and county policies, laws and regulations and national curriculum in regard to vocational training
- Creation of structures that promote delivery of quality education and training as provided in TVET Act, 2013
- Espouse promotion of the spirit of inclusion, peace, tolerance and integration in youth for a cohesive nation
- Entrenchment of sound management of resources, human, financial and material, in training Centres
- Promotion of perpetual succession in CTTI governance to preserve institutional memory
- Provision of opportunity to Makueni Citizenry to share knowledge and skills in their respective professional disciplines

- Development of model institutions that provide youth with opportunity to acquire affordable skills locally
- Promotion the spirit of constitutionalism by devolving CTTI governance
- Expansion and strengthening of resource mobilization structures for CTTIs to enhance sustainability
- Promotion of welfare and observance of human rights in training institutions

To ensure quality in technical and vocational education and training in Makueni, the department is deliberately focusing on promoting course specialization in CTTIs. This will ensure optimal utilization of available resources towards provision of relevant and market driven skills.




IVA System Brief


